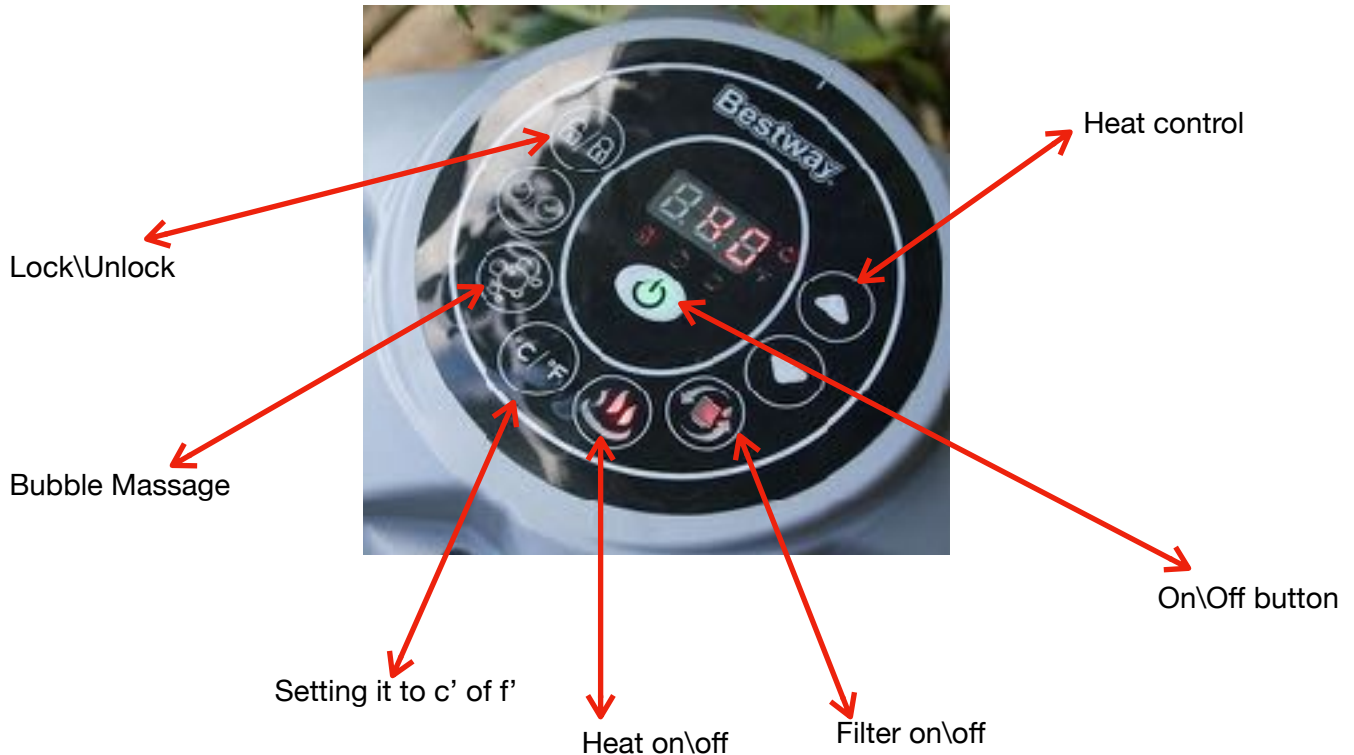


Hot Tub Instructions



Water level

The Water should be filled to between the min and maximum level, the water level should always stay between these two lines throughout the whole hire.

Turning the pump on

To turn the pump hold down the power button till beep (see diagram)

Heating

To control the heating level first you need to press the heat symbol (see diagram) this will light up, then the two arrows are to control the desired heat (see diagram).

Bubble Massage

To turn on the bubbles press the bubble button to turn on and press again to turn off. The bubbles will only last for up to 20minutes then the system will take a few moments to re set itself before pressing the bubble symbol again.

Filter/ cleaning

To keep the spa clean, the filter must be on all the time. To turn on press the filter button and will light up indicating it's on. Change filter EVERY morning and wash the dirty filter in the washing machine (on its own) at 30 Degrees. The filter fits inside the spa and will be shown how to connect/disconnect on set up. You will be provided 2 chlorine tablets, one will be put into the pump by us and will demonstrate to you how and when to put the second one in. To keep there spa clean use the net provided to clean out any visible dirt within the water such as grass.

Safety lock

The spa will automatically put the pump into a lock mode after a few moments, to unlock hold down the lock button (see diagram for a few seconds until you hear a beep).

Hot Tub Instructions

Getting ready for Collection

Make sure all equipment is put together ready for collection, clean where possible.

Emptying the water

We ask that all water is emptied where possible. To do this please follow the steps

1. Make sure the pump/lights are unplugged from the mains but not near the tub.
2. Turn the 3 connecting pipes (see diagram) anti clockwise until completely off, water will immediately start coming out.
3. Once the water level has dropped open the bottom cap (on the floor of the inflatable) at the bottom of the spa to release the rest of the water.
4. Keep the hot tub inflated so we can check condition before removing from your home.
5. Leave all other equipment gazebo/drink holders/ lights together with the hot tub.
